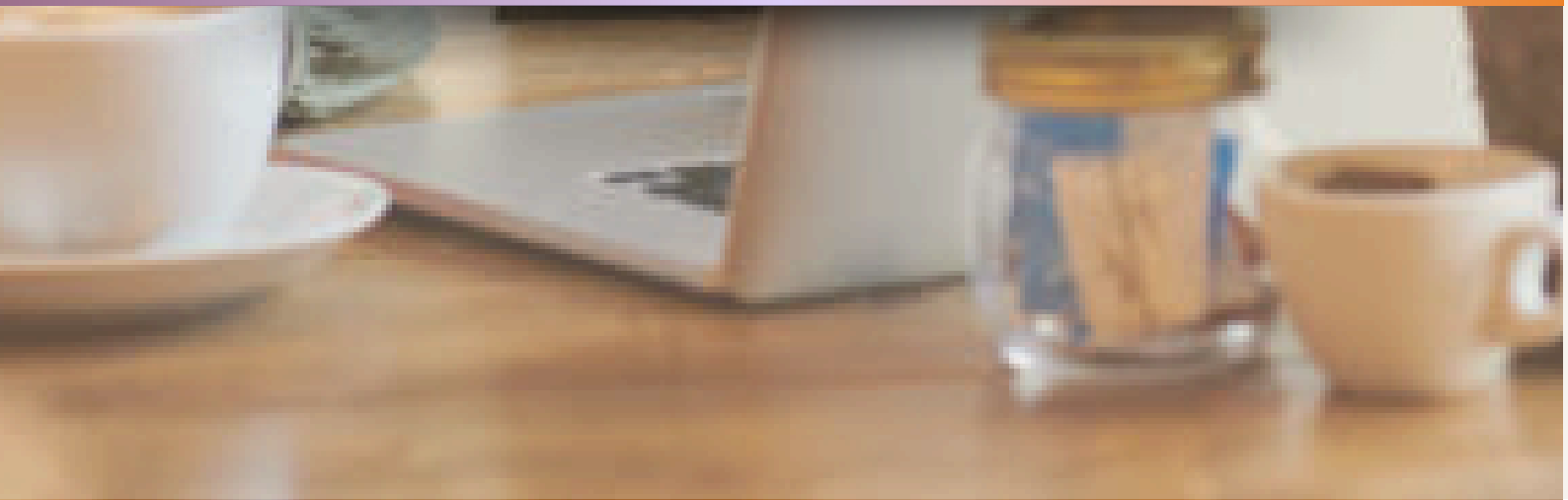

**WORLD NEEDS** - challenges, problems and opportunities in the world that surrounds you that you can solve.
