



Memory & Math Quick Play:

Setup:

Begin by placing all cards face down on whatever surface you are playing on in rows and columns

How To Play:

Play begins with the person who has visited the most places on all of these cards, once decided the player flips over two cards in order to find a pair, if a pair is not found the player to the left takes their turn.

If a pair is found pick up both cards and add them to a point pile next to you and take another turn until you can no longer find any pairs.

Points:

Cards from 1 – 9 are worth 10 points, Cards from 10 – 18 are worth 15 points.

Memory & Math Long Game:

Setup:

Begin by placing all cards face down on whatever surface you are playing on in rows and columns.

How To Play:

Play begins with the youngest person going first, once that player has picked up the first card of the pair they must answer a trivia question in relation to that place or destination, if the answer is correct the second card may be flipped over, if the question is not answered correctly the second card may not be picked up.
