



Adventure Games To Play While Worldschooling:

Digital;

1. Geocaching: Use GPS coordinates to hunt for hidden treasures in different countries..
2. Urban Orienteering: Navigate through a city, country or town using a map and compass, following clues to reach checkpoints.

Knowledge:

3. Explorer: Find specific exhibits, answer questions, or complete tasks in museums.
3. Art: Find specific exhibits, answer questions, or complete tasks in art galleries.
5. Seek & Find: Locate hidden objects in parks, beaches, sand sunes or historical landmarks.

FUN:

6. Scavenger Hunt: Create a list of clues leading to hidden objects and prizes.
7. Wild Scavenger Hunt: Explore natural areas, searching for a variety of plants, insects, or other wildlife.
8. Spyfall: (1) player is secretly assigned as a spy, while the other players try to deduce their true identity through clever questioning.

Life skills:

9. Navigation Challenge: Use a compass and map to navigate a predetermined route, learning basic orienteering skills.
10. Survival Skills: Learn practical skills like fire-starting, shelter-building, and first aid in a safe and controlled environment.
11. Brain Teasers: Solve puzzles, riddles, and mind-bending games to stimulate cognitive skills and creativity.

Memory:

12. Storytelling Adventure: Take turns creating an interactive story as you travel, adding twists, turns, and surprises along the way.
13. Travel Charades: Write down a list of your own Worldschool activities, cultural experiences and iconic landmarks, and act them out for others to guess.
14. Use the Worldschool Tribe Create & Play games to create locations quiz's, like a flash card game.
15. Memory Bucket List: Use the Worldschool Tribe cards to create a bucket list, number the destinations. Naming each destination with corresponding number to earn points. Highest points wins!
