TITRA – Terms of Use & Licensing Agreement (Trauma-Informed, Timeline Risk Assessment)

Owner & Creator: Kate Beesley, Say No DAS – Victim Voice Academy

1. Ownership & Intellectual Property

- The TITRA model, templates, and all associated resources remain the sole property of Kate Beesley.
- TITRA may not be copied, adapted, or rebranded without express written permission.

2. Use by Individuals & Survivors

- Survivors may use TITRA for personal use only, to record, structure, and present their experiences.
- Access to TITRA for survivors must be provided directly by Kate Beesley (Say No DAS / Victim Voice Academy), an approved TITRA Risk Assessor & Expert Witness, or by an organisation holding a valid TITRA licence.
- Personal use does not grant the right to:
 - Train others,
 - Embed TITRA into organisational frameworks, or
 - Share or distribute TITRA resources.

3. Use by Certified Professionals

- TITRA may only be used in a professional capacity by individuals who have:
 - Completed accredited training with Victim Voice Academy, and
 - Been certified by Kate Beesley as an Expert Witness / TITRA Risk Assessor.
- Certified professionals may:
 - Use TITRA within their casework and expert reports.
 - Share TITRA templates only with survivors they are directly working with.
 - Ensure any shared TITRA template is accompanied by:
 - A PDF copy of the Domestic Abuse Breakthrough Handbook, and
 - The Regulation Resources included in the Survivor Bundle.
- Certified professionals may not:
 - Share TITRA resources widely with teams, colleagues, or organisations.
 - Train others in TITRA.
 - Reproduce TITRA content in alternative formats.

4. Organisational Use & Licensing

- Any use of TITRA within organisations (including but not limited to police forces, local authorities, PCCs, universities, charities, or corporate teams) requires a formal licensing agreement with Kate Beesley.
- Licensing agreements are designed to protect the integrity, safe usage, and credibility of TITRA.

5. Prohibited Uses

You may not:

- Use TITRA without appropriate accreditation or licensing.
- Embed TITRA in training, bids, policies, or service frameworks without written agreement.
- Resell, sublicense, or redistribute TITRA materials.

6. Enforcement

- Breach of these terms may result in:
 - Revocation of your right to use TITRA, and
 - Legal action if necessary to protect intellectual property.

7. Acknowledgement

By using TITRA, you acknowledge that:

- You understand and agree to abide by these terms.
- You recognise TITRA as the intellectual property of Kate Beesley.
- You accept that safe and trauma-informed usage requires training, certification, and/or licensing.
- These terms apply to all past, current, and future users of TITRA.
- By continuing to use TITRA after the Effective Date, you agree to be bound by these updated terms.
- Survivors and professionals who obtained access prior to the Effective Date remain authorised to use TITRA within the limits set out in this agreement.

8. Copyright & Misuse Notice

TITRA is protected under copyright and intellectual property law.

Any copying, distribution, adaptation, or unauthorised use of TITRA, whether or not the Terms of Use have been accepted, constitutes a breach of these rights.

Action may be taken against any individual or organisation found to be misusing TITRA, including:

- Issuing takedown notices,
- Revocation of access, and
- Legal proceedings where necessary.
