You know you need a video doorbell, but there are so many choices. Different brands, models, prices and how do I know if it will even work in my home?



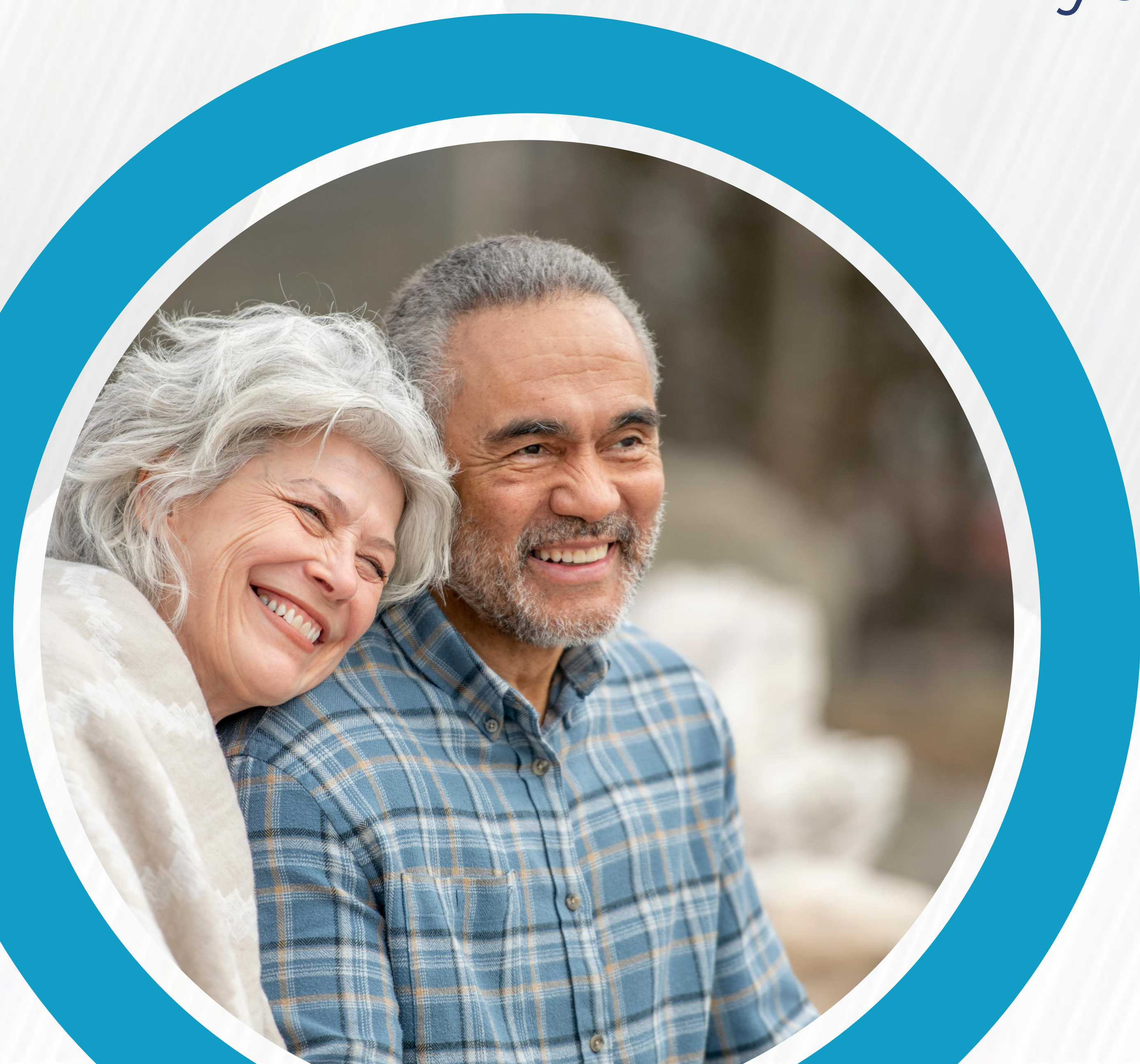

The Subscription

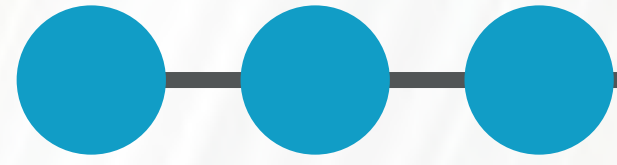
We really don't like subscriptions, but we soon realized the replay feature is crucial for effective monitoring.

While live video initially seemed sufficient, we discovered that without the ability to replay footage, important events could be missed.

This feature ensures we can review recent activity, similar to how a security guard monitors multiple screens. The subscription's minimal monthly cost is justified by this essential replay capability, for the security and effectiveness of your video doorbell.



DIY or Professional Install



Whether or not a video doorbell is a DIY project depends on your home's wiring and if you have suitable built-in doorbell wiring?



YES

If your modular home has built-in doorbell wiring, installing a video doorbell at the front door can be a DIY task. The existing transformer will likely be sufficient for a single video doorbell. However, many modular homes do not have wiring to the back door, where valuable items like cars and bikes are located, and makes backdoor installations more challenging.



DIY or Professional Install



RVs, Park models, and add-on Arizona Rooms are rarely pre-wired with doorbell wiring. Pre-wiring means having a transformer near the circuit breaker panel that supplies power to concealed doorbell wires.

Installation of hidden wiring is not a DIY job. A practical alternative is to use a nearby outlet with an AC adapter, then run the wire along the baseboard and trim, and through a hole to the outside.

This can be a complex task that many DIY enthusiasts and even some professional installers avoid.



DIY or Professional Install

? MAYBE

Even in pre-wired homes, video doorbells often require more power than the original wall chime setup.

Older transformers typically have a power rating of 10VA, while most video doorbells, including the Ring Doorbell2, require at least 14VA for one and 40VA for two.

Therefore, the existing transformer in a pre-wired home may not always be adequate.



For seniors living in manufactured housing communities, finding cost-effective installation solutions for video doorbells can be a challenge.
