When God Is Showing You Something, But the Way Forward Isn't Yet Clear.



God often begins by drawing your attention to something.

It may be a problem that needs to be solved, an idea that is beginning to take shape, a decision that requires more than conventional wisdom, or an assignment that seems important even though the way forward is not yet clear. **Sometimes it begins with a question.**

At other times, it is a growing awareness that something needs to change, something new needs to be developed, or an existing approach is no longer sufficient.

Recognizing that God is drawing your attention to something doesn't mean you immediately understand everything He is showing you or how to respond. Important information may still be missing, assumptions may need to be examined, and other people may need to be involved before the next step becomes clear.

This is where many Christian leaders struggle. You may be praying for direction and wanting to respond to God, but you've never been given a clear way to work through what you're receiving and move toward clarification, confirmation, development, and implementation.

Some people begin building before they understand the problem they're trying to solve, while others wait for every answer before taking action. You may be accustomed to relying on your own experience, or you may hesitate to use research, testing, and wise counsel because you're concerned that doing so could interfere with being led by the Holy Spirit.

The Holy Spirit leads throughout that work as you pray, ask questions, investigate what you need to understand, examine assumptions, seek wise counsel, consider possible solutions, and do the work required to bring an idea to fruition. Spiritual discernment and practical innovation can develop together as you remain attentive to His direction.

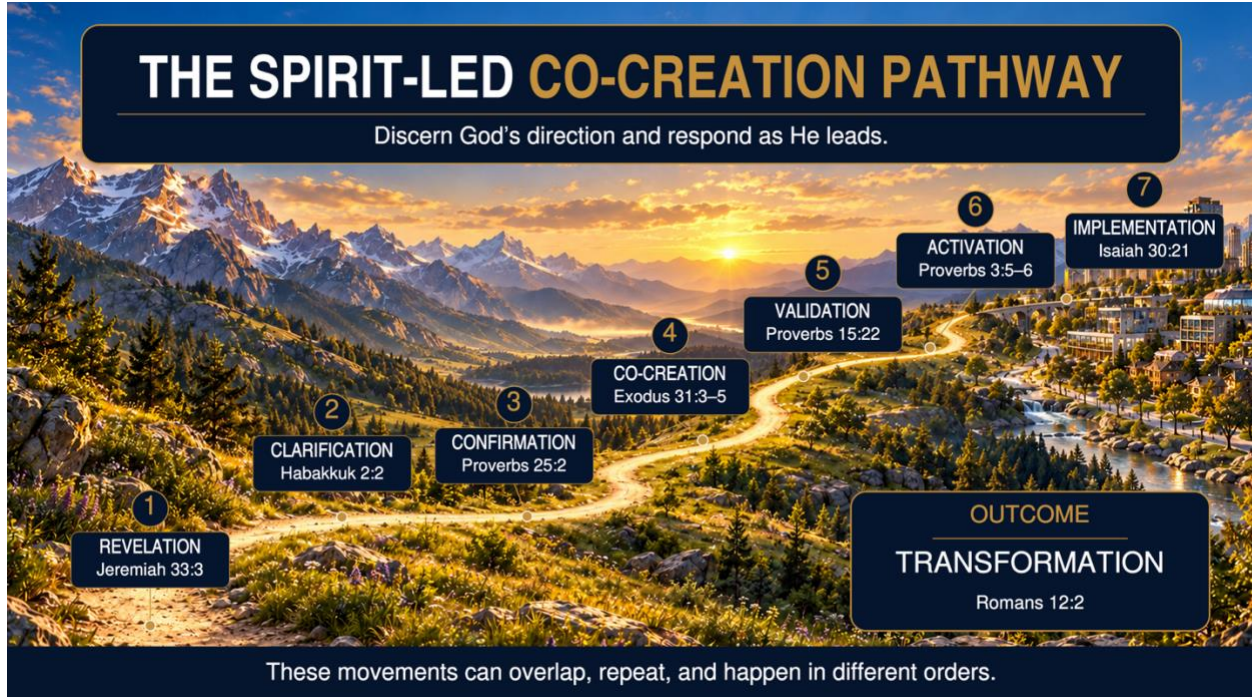

The Spirit-Led Co-Creation Pathway



The Spirit-Led Co-Creation Pathway provides a biblical pattern for discerning what God is showing you and stewarding that direction into faithful action. Its seven movements are

Revelation, Clarification, Confirmation, Co-Creation, Validation, Activation, and Implementation, with Transformation as the outcome.

These movements do not form a rigid sequence. They may overlap, repeat, or become clearer at different times. You may receive additional insight while investigating an idea, return to clarification after receiving wise counsel, or recognize during implementation that something still needs to be confirmed or refined.

REVELATION: [Jeremiah 33:3](#)

God reveals what He wants you to know.

Revelation begins when God draws your attention to something He wants you to recognize, understand, address, develop, or bring forward. It may come through Scripture, prayer, the leading of the Holy Spirit, a dream, a recurring question, an unmet need, a problem requiring a solution, a conversation, wise counsel, or something you observe in your work or community. You may be certain that God has revealed something while still needing further prayer, investigation, and discernment to understand its meaning and application.

CLARIFICATION: [Habakkuk 2:2](#)

You begin putting into words what God is showing you.

Clarification helps you move from a general impression toward a clearer understanding of the idea, problem, decision, or assignment in front of you. You begin identifying what you believe God is showing you, what you are trying to accomplish, why it matters, who may be affected, and what still needs to be understood. Writing the vision creates a starting point that can be examined, discussed, prayed over, and refined.

CONFIRMATION: [Proverbs 25:2](#)

You seek greater assurance and understanding.

Confirmation involves examining what you believe you have received rather than assuming your first interpretation is complete. This can include continued prayer, Scripture, the leading of the Holy Spirit, research, circumstances, wise counsel, and conversations with people who have relevant knowledge or experience. Confirmation may strengthen your understanding, reveal that part of the idea needs to change, or show you that more investigation is required.

CO-CREATION: [Exodus 31:3–5](#)

The Holy Spirit equips and leads as you develop the work.

Co-Creation is where inspiration begins taking form through the abilities, knowledge, creativity, experience, relationships, and resources God provides. The Holy Spirit leads, but you remain

actively involved. You ask questions, gather information, develop possibilities, make decisions, create, test, refine, and carry out the work required to bring the idea to fruition.

Co-creating with God is a posture of dependence, discernment, obedience, and active participation in what He is leading you to do throughout the journey. Within that relationship, the Co-Creation movement gives particular attention to developing the idea or work.

VALIDATION: [Proverbs 15:22](#)

You test assumptions and seek wise counsel.

Validation helps determine whether an idea addresses the actual problem, serves the people it is intended to serve, and can work within real conditions. This can include research, conversations, prototypes, feedback, testing, financial analysis, professional expertise, and counsel from people who can identify weaknesses or considerations you may have missed. Validation helps you steward the idea carefully before committing significant time, money, people, or other resources to it.

ACTIVATION: [Proverbs 3:5–6](#)

You commit to the direction and begin moving forward.

Activation gives particular attention to the decision and commitment to begin an assignment or move forward with a new part of work already underway. You may not have every answer, but you have enough clarity and confirmation to take the next appropriate step. That step may involve beginning a project, assembling a team, developing a prototype, making an introduction, allocating resources, testing an approach, or acting on a decision. Activation requires trust in God while continuing to seek His direction as the work develops.

IMPLEMENTATION: [Isaiah 30:21](#)

You carry out the work required to bring the idea to fruition.

Implementation involves translating the idea into sustained action. Plans are carried out, responsibilities are assigned, resources are managed, progress is evaluated, problems are addressed, and adjustments are made as new information becomes available. The Holy Spirit continues to lead throughout implementation. Moving forward does not end the need for prayer, discernment, wise counsel, or course correction.

OUTCOME: TRANSFORMATION: [Romans 12:2](#)

God accomplishes His purposes through what He develops in you and through you.

Transformation is the outcome of the Pathway. It can include the change produced through the idea, solution, decision, or assignment itself, as well as the change that takes place within the

person doing the work. Through the process, thinking can be renewed, character strengthened, assumptions corrected, relationships developed, leadership deepened, and a greater capacity created to recognize and respond to God’s direction in the future.

The result may affect an individual, business, ministry, organization, community, industry, or nation. The full impact may extend beyond what could have been seen when the original revelation was received. The Spirit-Led Co-Creation Pathway keeps the entire process grounded in a central understanding:

God reveals what He wants you to know. The Holy Spirit equips and leads you. You faithfully respond and do the work. God accomplishes His purposes through you.

The 7i Innovation Framework



The 7i Innovation Framework provides the practical, repeatable innovation process within Co-Creating with GOD: Spirit-Led Innovation. Where the Spirit-Led Co-Creation Pathway helps you discern and steward God-given direction, the 7i Innovation Framework helps you investigate, develop, evaluate, refine, and implement the idea or solution connected with that direction.

The Framework includes Illuminate, Investigate, Incubate, Imagine, Interpret, Interact, and Ignite. These seven elements provide structure without requiring every idea to develop in exactly the same way.

New information may cause you to return to an earlier element of the Framework, reconsider an assumption, investigate another question, or refine the solution before moving forward. Prayer, Scripture, the leading of the Holy Spirit, research, creativity, testing, wise counsel, and practical work remain integrated throughout the process.

1i ILLUMINATE

Bring the idea, problem, or assignment into clearer focus.

Illuminate begins by identifying what has drawn your attention and what you are trying to understand, solve, develop, or accomplish. You begin clarifying the current situation, the need you have recognized, the people affected, the desired result, and the questions that need to be answered. A problem defined too broadly can become difficult to address. A problem defined too narrowly may cause you to focus on a symptom while overlooking the underlying issue. Illuminate helps establish a clearer starting point.

2i INVESTIGATE

Gather the information needed to understand what you are dealing with.

Investigate moves beyond initial impressions and assumptions. You examine the current situation, study the people and conditions involved, research what has already been tried, identify constraints, and look for information that can confirm or challenge your understanding.

Investigation can include interviews, observation, market research, historical research, financial analysis, technical information, professional expertise, biblical study, and conversations with people who have firsthand experience. The purpose is to discover what you need to know before deciding what the solution should be.

3i INCUBATE

Allow what you are learning to develop and connect.

Incubate creates room for research, experience, prayer, insight, and observation to begin forming new connections. Some understanding comes through direct analysis. Other insights emerge after the mind has had time to process what has been learned. A detail that initially seemed unrelated may become important, or a question may lead to a different understanding of the problem. Incubation can include reviewing information, organizing findings, revisiting questions, discussing the idea with others, stepping away temporarily, and remaining attentive to what the Holy Spirit brings to your awareness.

4i IMAGINE

Develop multiple possibilities before committing to one solution.

Imagine is about using your God-given imagination to consider what could be developed, changed, combined, improved, removed, or approached differently.

Instead of accepting the first workable answer, you generate several possible solutions and consider the problem from different perspectives. The purpose is to develop a stronger range of possibilities that can be examined and refined.

5i INTERPRET

Evaluate what has been discovered and determine what it means.

Interpret helps you make sense of the information, insights, patterns, and possible solutions developed through the earlier elements of the Framework. You compare possibilities, identify strengths and weaknesses, consider consequences, examine feasibility, and evaluate how well each option addresses the actual problem and desired result.

Data can inform a decision, but it does not make the decision by itself. Prayer, discernment, biblical principles, experience, professional expertise, and an understanding of the people affected all contribute to deciding which direction should move forward.

6i INTERACT

Involve the people whose insight, experience, feedback, or participation is needed.

Other people can identify assumptions you have overlooked, raise questions you have not considered, contribute specialized knowledge, test whether the solution makes sense, and help determine how it may work under real conditions.

Interaction can include wise counsel, interviews, advisory conversations, collaboration, prototypes, pilot programs, customer or user feedback, professional review, and discussions with the people who will implement or be affected by the solution. The goal is to involve people whose perspective is relevant and use what is learned to strengthen the idea.

7i IGNITE

Move the developed and validated idea into implementation.

Ignite is where the work begins moving from development into sustained action. This can include finalizing the plan, assigning responsibilities, securing resources, establishing timelines, launching a pilot, introducing the solution, measuring results, and making adjustments based on what happens during implementation. Implementation often reveals information that could not have been known earlier. New challenges may require additional investigation, interpretation, interaction, or refinement.

How the Framework Helps You Move Forward

The 7i Innovation Framework helps you slow down long enough to understand what you are dealing with before committing to a solution. It helps you separate assumptions from facts, ask better questions, develop more than one possible answer, involve people whose insight is needed, and determine what it will take to move toward implementation.

How the Pathway and Framework Work Together



The Spirit-Led Co-Creation Pathway and the 7i Innovation Framework serve different but complementary purposes. The Pathway provides the biblical pattern for discerning what God is showing you and stewarding that direction from Revelation through Implementation, with Transformation as the outcome.

The Framework provides the practical, repeatable innovation process for investigating, developing, evaluating, refining, and implementing the idea or solution connected with that direction.

The Pathway Helps You Discern and Steward God-Given Direction

The Pathway keeps the process grounded in prayer, Scripture, the leading of the Holy Spirit, wise counsel, faithful response, and dependence on God.

It helps you consider questions such as:

- What is God drawing my attention to?
- What do I believe He is showing me?
- What still needs to be clarified or confirmed?
- How is the Holy Spirit equipping and leading me?
- What needs to be tested or validated?
- What action am I being led to take?
- What work is required to carry this through implementation?
- What transformation is God accomplishing in me and through what is being developed?

The Framework Helps You Develop and Implement the Idea

The 7i Innovation Framework provides greater structure for working through the practical questions connected with an idea, problem, decision, or assignment.

It helps you:

- Bring the idea or problem into clearer focus
- Separate assumptions from facts
- Investigate what you need to understand
- Recognize patterns and connections
- Develop multiple possible solutions
- Evaluate what has been discovered
- Involve people whose insight or participation is needed
- Test the proposed idea or solution under real conditions
- Move the developed idea toward implementation

They Do Not Correspond One-to-One

The seven movements of the Pathway and the seven elements of the Framework are not intended to be matched one-to-one. Clarification may involve Illuminate, Investigate, and Interact. Confirmation may draw from Investigate, Interpret, and wise counsel received through Interact.

Validation may require several elements of the Framework as research is examined, possible solutions are tested, feedback is received, and adjustments are made. In the same way, one elements of the Framework may support several movements of the Pathway. The relationship changes according to what is being developed and what is learned along the way.

The Holy Spirit Leads Throughout Both

Using a practical, repeatable innovation process does not replace prayer or Spirit-Led discernment. Seeking God's direction also does not remove the need to investigate, ask questions, test assumptions, involve other people, make decisions, and carry out the work.

The Holy Spirit leads throughout the Pathway and Framework. You remain prayerfully engaged, use the abilities and resources God provides, respond to what is being revealed, and continue seeking direction as the work develops.

Together, the Pathway and Framework help you connect what God is showing you with the work needed to bring it to fruition. The Pathway keeps your attention on discerning and stewarding His direction, while the Framework helps you investigate, develop, test, and implement the idea or solution connected with it.

What You Can Bring Into the Training

You do not need a fully developed idea or complete plan before beginning the Spirit-Led Innovation Training. You may know exactly what you are trying to develop, or you may only recognize that God is drawing your attention to something requiring further prayer, investigation, and discernment.

The training is designed to help you begin where you are and work toward greater clarity.

You can bring:

- An idea you are beginning to explore
- A problem you need to understand or solve
- A decision requiring greater clarity and discernment
- A product or service you are developing
- A business, ministry, organization, or initiative you are preparing to begin
- An existing approach that needs to be improved
- An assignment you believe God has placed in front of you
- A situation where you know something needs to change but do not yet understand the solution
- A project already underway that has become stalled, unclear, or more complicated than expected
- A solution that needs to be tested before committing additional time, money, people, or other resources

You can also use the training to examine something that appears to be working. Innovation can involve understanding why an approach is effective, identifying where it could be strengthened, preparing for changing conditions, or determining how it could serve more people without losing its original purpose.

As you work through the training, you will learn how to clarify what you are trying to accomplish, identify what you know, separate assumptions from facts, recognize what still needs to be investigated, develop possible solutions, seek wise counsel, involve people whose insight is needed, and decide how to move forward.

I strongly recommend choosing something real to apply the training to. Working through an actual idea, problem, decision, or assignment gives you a practical context for using the Pathway and Framework while continuing to pray, listen, learn, and respond to God's direction. Without that practical application, the teaching can remain theoretical.

How to Begin

As you work through the training, I encourage you to give yourself time to understand the Spirit-Led Co-Creation Pathway and the 7i Innovation Framework and begin applying them to your own ideas, problems, decisions, and assignments. Pausing to pray, take notes, investigate a question, or try what you're learning is part of how the training becomes useful in your life and work.

1. Begin With the Welcome and Start Here Materials

Enter the FREE Member Hub and begin with the Welcome and Start Here materials. Then listen to the **Origin Story audio** and watch the **Spirit-Led Co-Creation Pathway video**. 2. Choose Something to Keep in Mind

Choose an idea, problem, decision, or assignment that matters to you and keep it in mind as you work through the sessions. Even if you don't understand it fully yet, it will give you something specific to clarify, investigate, develop, improve, or bring to fruition as you apply what you're learning.

3. Complete the BASIC Seminar

The BASIC Seminar introduces the complete 7i Innovation Framework and establishes the foundation for understanding how Spirit-Led discernment and practical innovation work together. Pause between sessions to review your notes, pray about what you are learning, and consider how it relates to your situation.

4. Continue Into the ADVANCED Workshop

The ADVANCED Workshop explores the principles, questions, and practices behind the Framework in greater depth. It will help you examine assumptions, understand problems more clearly, conduct meaningful investigation, develop possible solutions, and involve people whose insight or experience is needed.

5. Use the DEEP DIVE Sessions to Strengthen Implementation

After completing the BASIC Seminar and ADVANCED Workshop, continue into the DEEP DIVE Sessions and begin spending time in the Wisdom Library. The DEEP DIVE Sessions focus on applying and implementing the Framework and understanding the conditions that support productive flow. By this point, you'll also be better prepared to connect the Wisdom Library material with the teaching and your own questions and circumstances.

6. Pause and Apply What You Are Learning

Pause when a question relates directly to what you are working through. Write down what you know, identify what you are assuming, note what still needs to be investigated, and consider who may have relevant insight. Apply each part as you move through the training rather than waiting until the end.

7. Return to Earlier Sessions When Needed

As the work develops, new information, a conversation, or the results of testing may change how you understand the problem or show you that a possible solution needs to be revised. When that happens, return to the sessions that help you examine what you've learned, revisit the relevant questions, and decide how to move forward.

8. Move at a Pace That Supports Understanding

Some Members may complete the training over several days. Others may work through it over several weeks while applying each part to an active idea or assignment. Choose a pace that allows you to remain prayerfully engaged, absorb the material, and carry what you are learning

into your life and work. The goal is to develop a way of discerning, thinking, investigating, creating, and moving forward that you can continue using long after completing the training.

No. The FREE 30-Day Email Onboarding and Training Series helps you get started and supports you as you work through the training. The PREMIUM Guided Email Training goes into more detail. It helps you look more closely at the teaching and think through how to apply it to your own circumstances.

Who is this training for?

This training is for believers who want to develop ideas, solve problems, make decisions, and respond to God's direction.

That includes Christian business leaders, executives, founders, entrepreneurs, inventors, advisors, ministry and nonprofit leaders, educators, and professionals. You can apply the teaching in business, ministry, education, coaching, consulting, creative work, community projects, and everyday life.

You don't need a particular title or background. If you're working through a challenge, developing an idea, or responding to an assignment you believe God has given you, this training was created with you in mind.

Do I need an active project or a fully developed idea to begin?

No. But I strongly recommend choosing something real to apply the training to. It could be an idea you want to develop, a problem you need to solve, a decision you're facing, or an assignment you believe God has placed in front of you.

You don't need to have it all figured out. Working with something real helps you connect the teaching to your own circumstances and begin putting it into practice. Otherwise, it's easy to listen to the teaching without doing much with it.

What if I don't consider myself an innovator?

That's fine. You don't have to think of yourself as an innovator to go through this training. Innovation often begins with recognizing a need, seeing a possibility, developing an idea, or solving a problem. You may already be doing some of these things without calling them innovation. The training helps you understand how to develop an idea further and work through what it will take to make it work.

Do I need experience with innovation or artificial intelligence?

No. You don't need previous innovation training, technical expertise, or experience using artificial intelligence. The training begins with the fundamentals of the Spirit-Led Co-Creation Pathway and the 7i Innovation Framework and explains how to use them.

What does "Co-Creating with GOD" mean?

Co-creating with God means seeking His direction and putting what He shows you into practice. It involves learning to steward the ideas, insights, wisdom, creativity, responsibilities, and assignments He entrusts to you. It doesn't mean being equal with God as Creator. **God alone is Creator.** Co-creating with Him means serving Him, depending on Him, seeking His wisdom, and responding to His direction.

Is this training biblically grounded?

Yes. The training is rooted in biblical principles of stewardship, wisdom, discernment, creativity, obedience, and purposeful action. It also draws from decades of innovation research and practical application, with Scripture as the foundation. **Biblical wisdom comes first.**

Does this replace prayer, Scripture, or hearing God's voice?

No. You still need prayer, Scripture, wise counsel, character, obedience, humility, and the leading of the Holy Spirit. The Spirit-Led Co-Creation Pathway and the 7i Innovation Framework help you work through what God has placed in front of you. They help you ask questions, investigate what you're considering, and work through what to do next. **God remains the source.**

How does AI fit into this training?

AI is a tool that can augment and enhance research, learning, and creative work. The training explores how to use AI without letting it do your thinking for you. Prayer, Scripture, wise counsel, and the leading of the Holy Spirit remain central throughout. **AI doesn't replace your judgment or spiritual discernment.**

How long does the training take to complete?

The complete training includes 17+ hours of on-demand video instruction. The time you spend will also depend on how much time you give to prayer, reflection, note-taking, research, and putting the teaching into practice.

You can work at your own pace and revisit sessions as needed. The 30-Day Email Onboarding and Training Series supports your learning. **You don't need to complete the training in 30 days.**

Where should I begin, and what order should I follow?

I recommend beginning with the Welcome and Start Here materials in the FREE Member Hub, followed by the Origin Story audio and the Spirit-Led Co-Creation Pathway video. Then go through **Become Invaluable in the Age of AI** and **How Will You Compete with AI?**

Next, work through the BASIC Seminar and the ADVANCED Workshop. After completing both, continue into the DEEP DIVE Sessions and begin using the Wisdom Library. You can return to earlier sessions whenever you need to review something or work through how it applies to your situation.

Can I pause and return to the training later?

Yes. The training is available on demand. You can pause when you need to, return when your schedule allows, and revisit individual sessions as often as needed.

Can I use the training with an existing project or organization?

Use the Spirit-Led Co-Creation Pathway to help you discern and respond to God's direction, and the 7i Innovation Framework to investigate, develop, validate, and implement ideas or solutions.
