- Surround yourself with encouraging voices that remind you of God's promises and motivate you to keep pressing on.

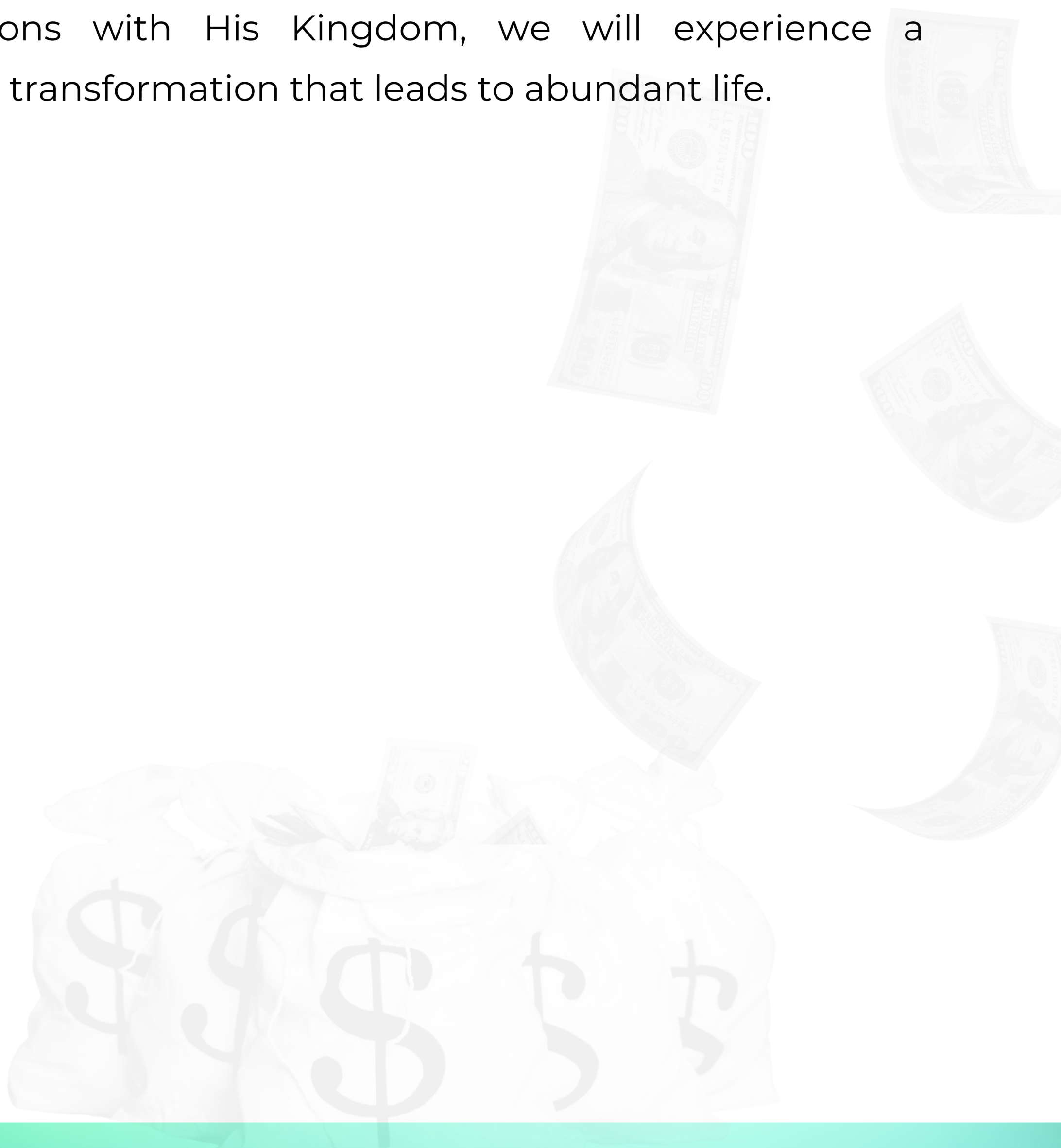
