$\$27 \times 19 \text{ sales} = \$513$

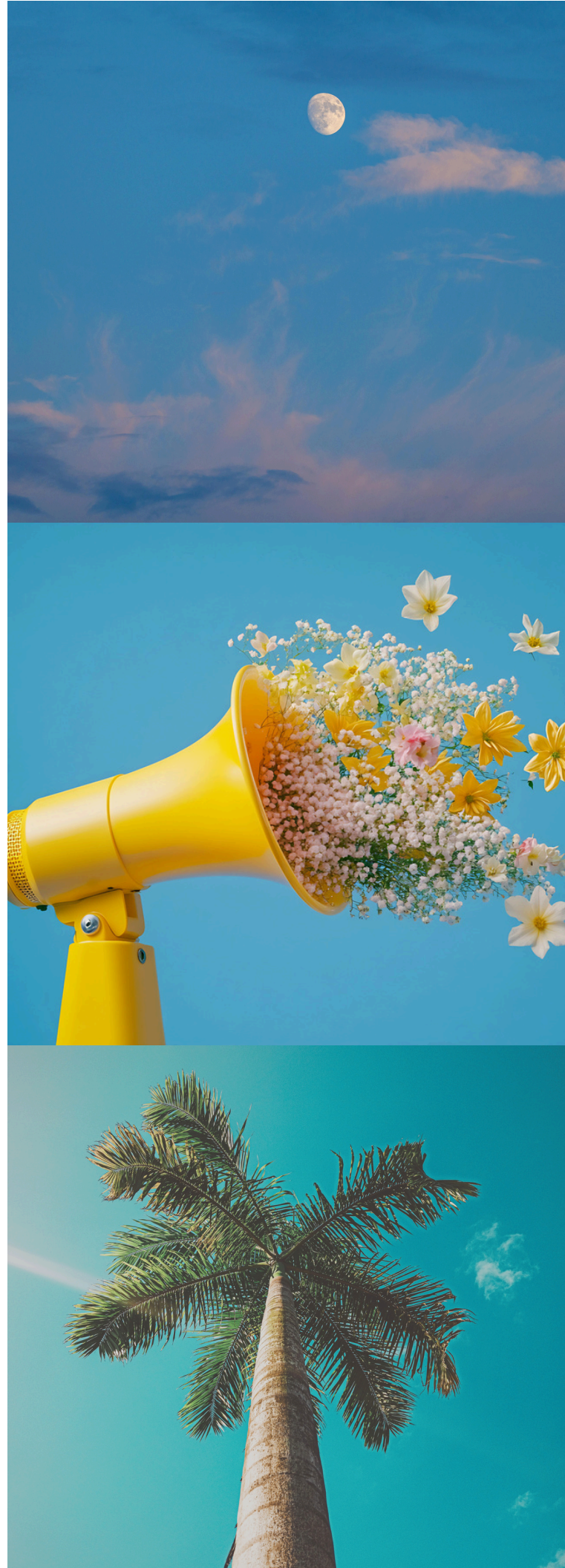
## 5.) This Is Not Viral Success

## 6.) Clarity Plus Consistency Is Enough

# YOUR CHECKLIST:

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## **Choose ONE Problem you already understand as a mom**

Write down the top 3 frustrations you've personally dealt with in the last year (time, money, routines, organization, homeschooling, meals, stress). Circle the one you could explain to another mom in five minutes. That's your problem.

*Example:*

*You constantly worry about grocery costs and meal planning on one income. You've learned how to plan simple meals that stay within budget. That problem—feeding a family without overspending—is a real product opportunity.*

## **Choose What Type of Mom you want to help**

Decide who this product is for by answering: "Who was I when this problem felt hardest?" Be specific about her stage of life, daily responsibilities, and main struggle. Clear focus makes your product easier to create and sell.

*Example:*

*A stay-at-home mom with 2-3 kids who manages groceries and meals on a tight monthly budget and feels stressed every time she shops.*

## **Choose Simple One Product Format**

Choose the fastest format you can finish in one week or less. Use this rule:

- Steps → checklist
- Planning → planner
- Instructions → short guide
- Start simple so you can move forward without overthinking.

*Example:*

*Instead of writing a long ebook, you create a 1-week budget meal planning checklist with a grocery list and meal rotation. It's simple, practical, and easy to finish.*

# YOUR CHECKLIST:

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## **Write a clear promise: “This helps her \_\_\_ without \_\_\_”**

Complete this sentence clearly and honestly. Focus on one result and one frustration she wants to avoid. This promise becomes your product title, description, and marketing message.

*Example:*

## **Create the product once**

Set a short deadline (3–5 days) and create only what is necessary to deliver the promise. Do not add extras or bonuses yet. A finished, simple product is always more powerful than a perfect one that never launches.

*Example:*

*You open Canva, choose a checklist template, add your meal plan and grocery list, and export it as a PDF. You finish in one afternoon instead of stretching it over weeks.*

## **Share it simply and consistently**

Pick one place to share your product—email, Instagram, Facebook, or direct messages. Share who it helps, what it solves, and where to get it. Repeat the same message weekly so people have time to notice and trust you.

*Example:*

*Once a week, you share:*

*“I created a simple meal planning checklist that helps moms stay on budget without stress. Message me if you want it.”*

*You post this on Facebook or send it to your email list consistently.*

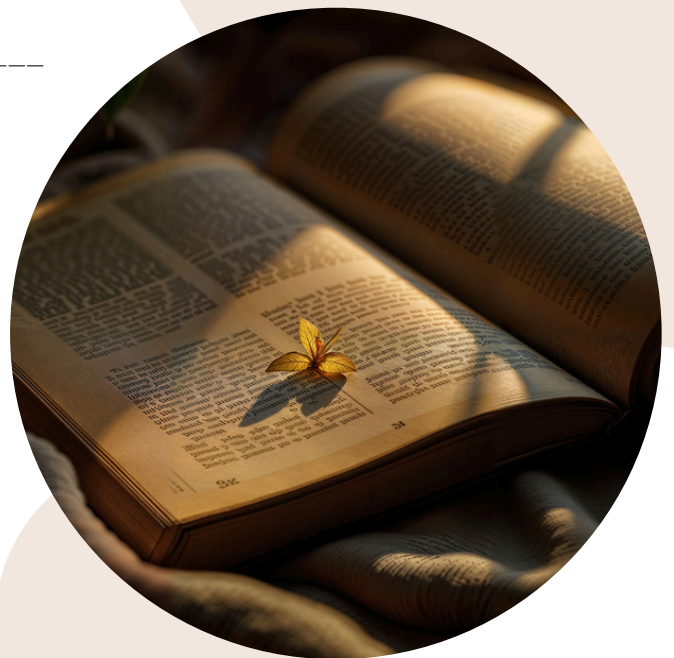
