Copying Pages

> If the five pages are insufficient, please follow below instructions

1. Select VIEW > Page Break Preview
2. Navigate onto the left side of the spreadsheet, where the rows are annotated with numbers
3. Select all rows from top to bottom of the final page of the spreadsheet.
4. Place your cursor on the row where you would like your new page to start. This should be just after the current page end for optimal printing.



Copying the Sheet For the Next Year

> The best way would be to duplicate the file and re-name it each year. It is best to keep an empty copy at hand, so you do not need to delete information each year.

You can also duplicate sheets within this document as below:

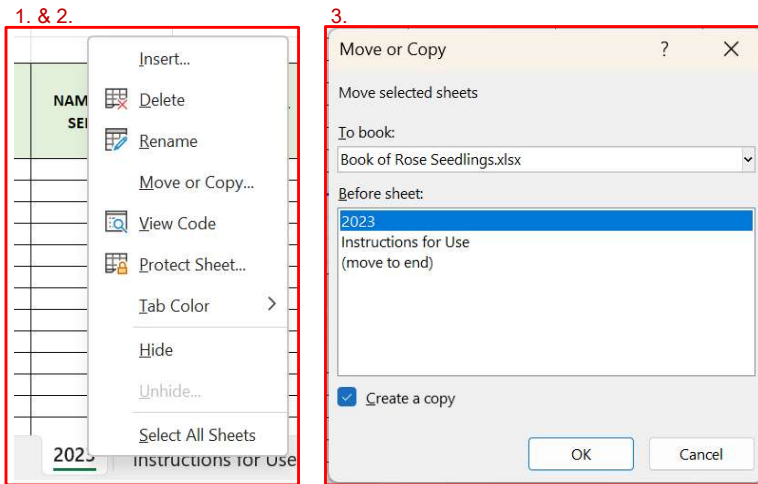
> Copying the sheet this way will retain all formulas; you will however need to clear all contents after copying, so it's best to do so before the year is filled out

> When the Number of Hips, Number of Seeds and Germination numbers are not filled in, this will show an error message of 'DIV/O!'

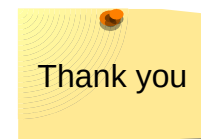
1. Navigate to the bottom left corner and right-click the '2023' tab (or whichever year)

2. Click 'Move or Copy'

3. Select the page to be copied, make sure you select 'Create a copy'

On the Facebook page, you will be able to report on your germination, development and flowering of your rose seedlings, and post pictures. How exciting! If you are lucky and your rose is good, you will be the one who, despite the fact that you may not even have a rose garden at home, will get your own rose and grow it in a pot on a sunny balcony or terrace! But if you have a garden or will give it to someone else who will plant it in their garden, this rose will be a precious memory for you and the person to whom you will give the rose.
