Personal / business account opening possible	Only personal for non-residents. Business account only for a domestic entity.	Both personal and business accounts possible for non-residents and foreign entities.	Only personal account opening possible.	Personal and business account opening possible for non-residents and domestic entities.
Can you open it from home?	Yes. Personal, no trip needed.	Yes, if it's set up the right way. Personal and business can both be opened remotely.	Yes. You never have to go there.	Depends. Fintechs, yes. With a physical high street bank it comes down to certain factors, such as reaching a specific balance within a set timeframe.
How long it takes	A few days to a few weeks	About 1 to 2 weeks for personal, around 4 weeks for business	2 to 3 weeks	Same day in person, personal or business. About a week remotely, if you qualify.
Currencies	GEL, USD, EUR, GBP and more	USD, EUR	USD, EUR, GBP, AED	USD. Some fintechs add others.
Good fit if you	Want a bank account outside Europe, or are a digital nomad with no fixed base. Also for spreading your money outside Europe.	Want to hold USD and EUR outside the US and Europe, or do business in Latin America. Also for a crypto-friendly bank account, or as a digital nomad who wants money in a strong banking landscape.	Want to diversify outside Europe and need a very solid banking system.	Sell to US customers or get paid through Stripe, PayPal or Amazon. Also for diversifying outside Europe.
